### Level 2 Unit UV20437

The purpose of this qualification is to develop your skills in beauty therapy to a high level of occupational ability, to enable you to perform your own salon services in how to apply makeup. This course covers: Day, Evening, Specialised make-up. We are delighted to use the mii cosmetic range, which is even suitable for sensitive and all skin types. You will develop an underpinning knowledge and understanding of the practical skills learned throughout this qualification.

### **How is the course charges applied?**

**Basic cost-** Theory and Practical's £477.50, Theory registration exam £57.50, plus 3 **assessments** required at £55 each Totalling £700

### **Payment Details**

Full payment for course required 1 month prior to practical training days. £150 deposit required to secure dates. Instalments available by arrangement

**Discounts** are given to students registering on more than one course

**Vouchers** are given to students who introduce an new student who register for a course with Acacia Academy

**When can I start my course?** Immediately, as soon as you make your initial payment you will receive you worksheets to start your studies.

**On paying for your course you would receive the Acacia theory online reading book, which you can use to complete your theory questions prior to practical days: this enables you to enjoy practical time with knowledge of understanding and gain maximum practical experience.**

**What do you need to bring with you for training days?** You will need to provide your own

- Stationary
- Printing
- Uniform
- Products
- Therapy Tools & Kits ( use of academy products by arrangement , a small charge is applied )

**Do I need have all items prior to arrival?** Ideally you need to be prepared but if you do not have a kit or are unaware of professional brands and up to date beauty wholesalers, we can give you advice on your purchase, or pre order your items for you ready for class.

**Do I need to be concerned the classes will not go head if there is not enough numbers registered?** No, Acacia is a Private Training Centre which prides itself in accommodating the individual as such, training days are ongoing and rolling (continuous).

**What can you do after this qualification?** Continue with more therapy subject units to complete a Full Level 2 Beauty Diploma: A full Diploma level 2 Beauty Therapy consists of Health and Safety, Customer care, Facials, Makeup, Eye treatments, Manicure, Pedicure, Waxing.

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**Can I use the makeup unit alongside another Unit?** Yes, for a full Certificate/ Diploma in makeup you need two other units Health and Safety and Customer Care, which you can take along with the waxing Unit. When sitting your makeup assessments, you may take alongside the assessments in Health and Safety and Customer Care assessments at no additional charge, (saving £135). You would need to complete the Health and Safety and Customer Care work packs and multiple choice exams of which there is a charge: see details on the next page.

**Do I have to repeat Health and Safety and Customer Care each time I take a level 2 Therapy unit?** No, UV20453 Client care and communication in beauty-related industries & UV20483 Follow health and safety practice in the salon are only required to be completed once for a full diploma i.e. with your first Therapy (which maybe makeup ).

**External Verifying Date – 6 monthly standardisation appointments**

If you are selected to attend the external verifier day it is compulsory therefore it is best to put the date in your diary

## INDEX
